Art Competition


"An artist is not paid for his labour but for his vision"

Principal Smt. Vishalakshi greeted the teachers for their relentless efforts in shaping the lives of the students.




The programme ended by proposing the vote of thanks followed by the National Anthem.

"Honouring Hindi is all about honouring our mother tongue"


Hindi Diwas was celebrated on 14th September to promote the importance of our National Language – Hindi.
