The competition for classes 4 to 8 was scrabble board.

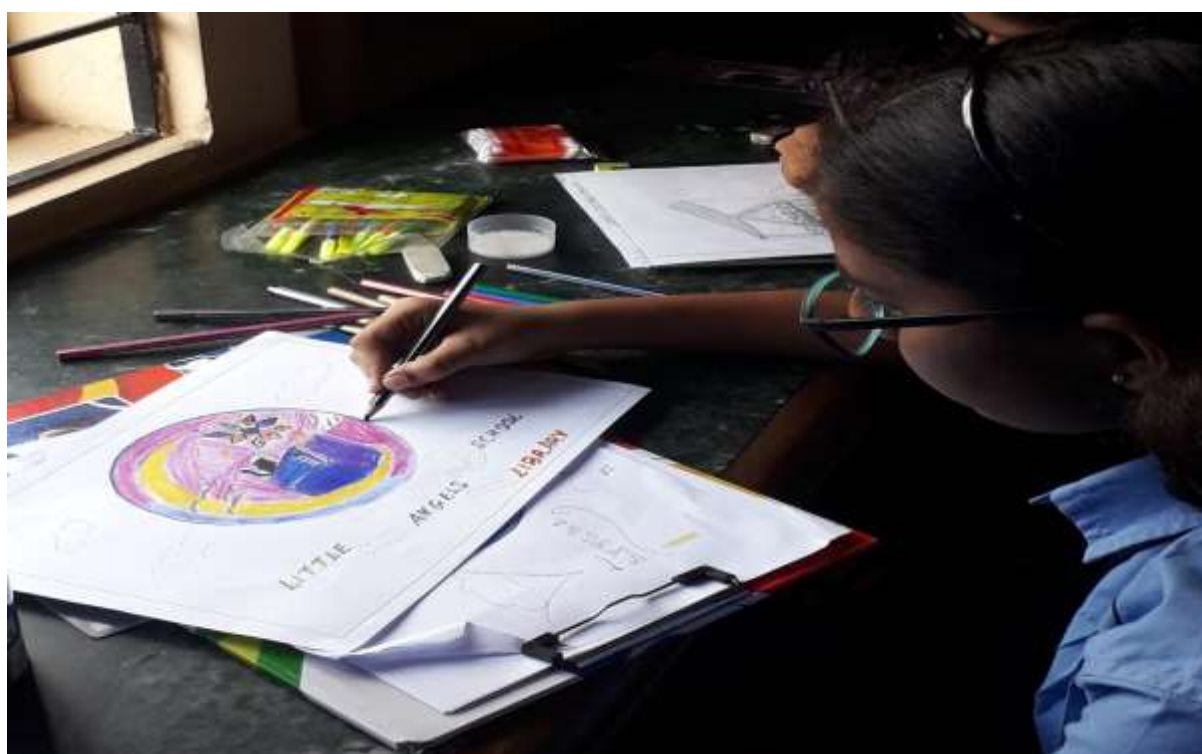
Students participated with lot of enthusiasm.

e.g., Hare and Tortoise, Thirsty Crow etc.



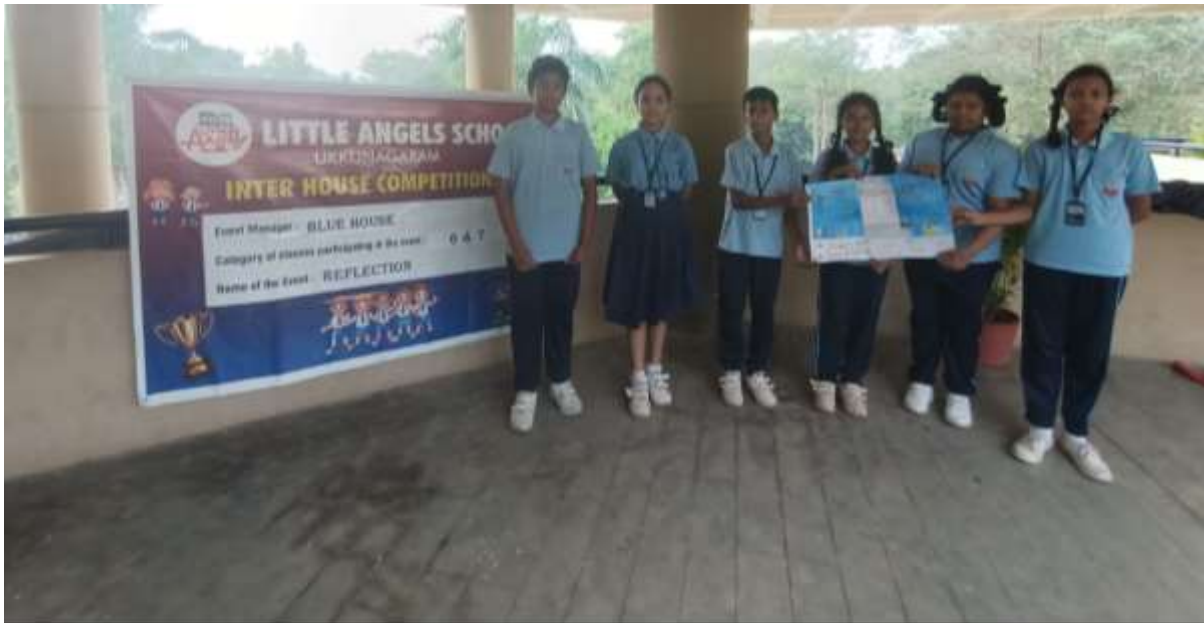
Driving Dreams:

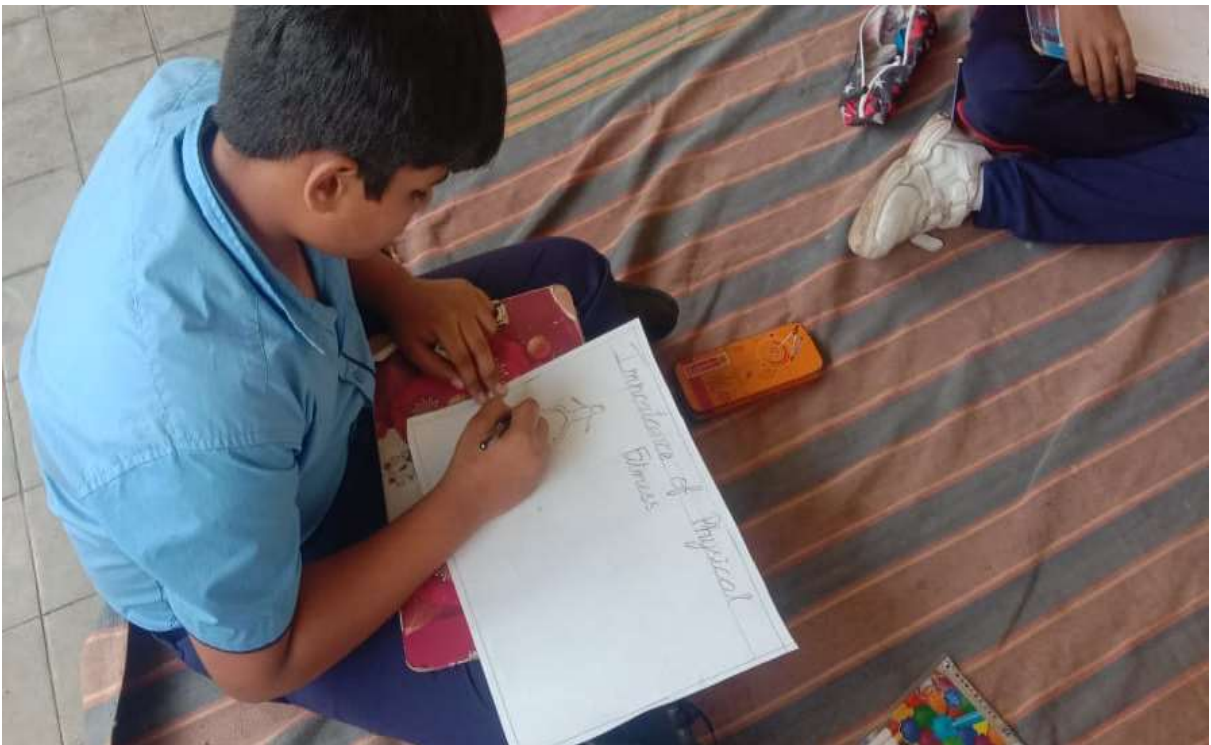


Poster making competition: -
