As a part of National library week celebration the school conducted a three day book exhibition from 4th Nov to 6th November .

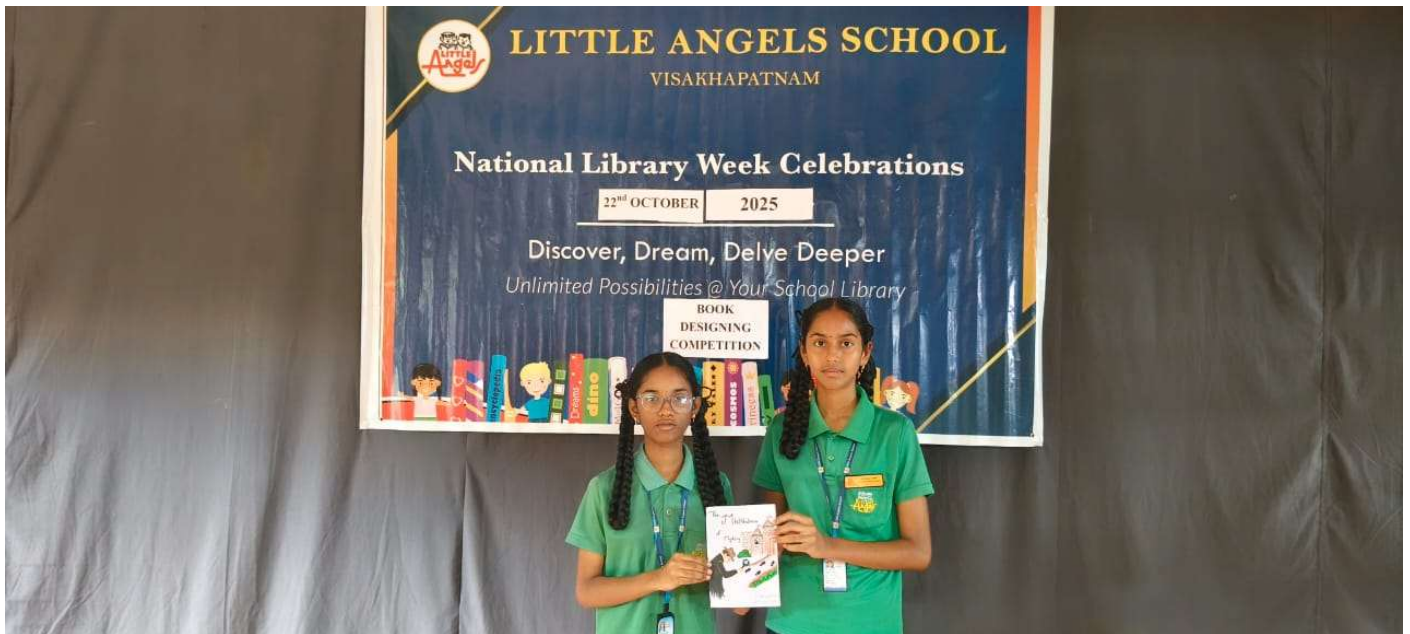

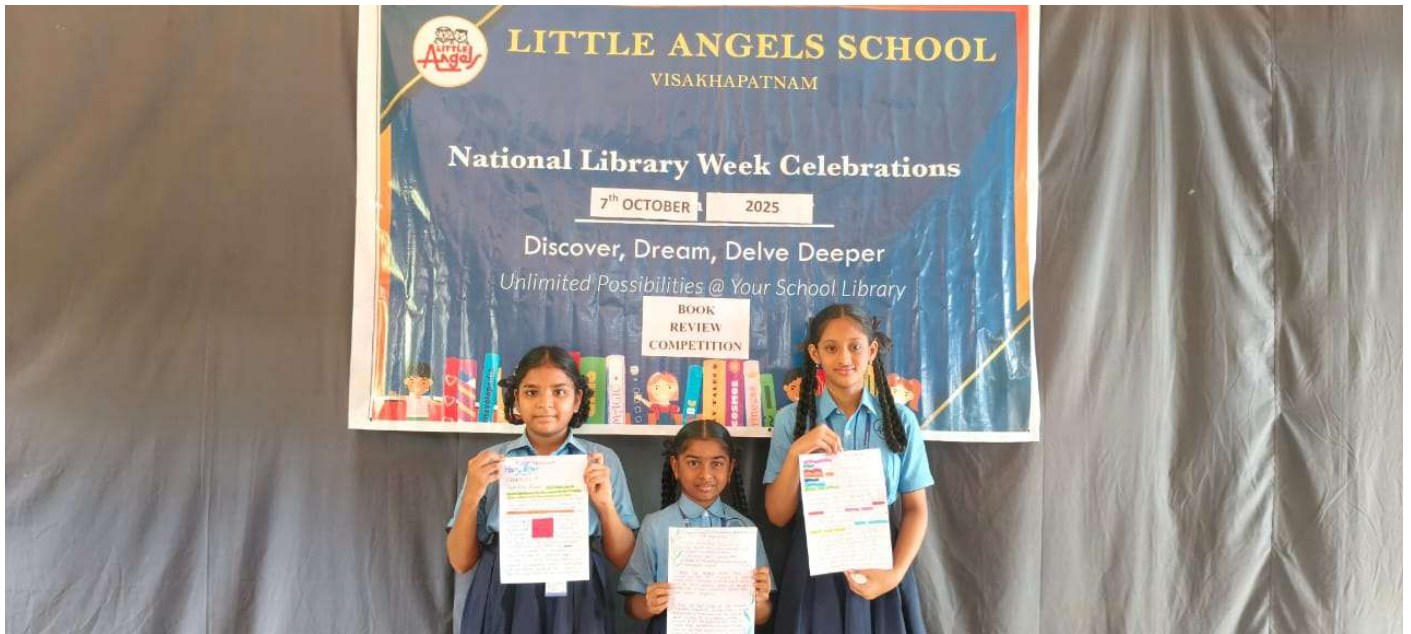
The Students of classes 6 to 10 thoroughly enjoyed browsing the books and exploring the picture gallery.

The students of class 7 visited “Avani Organic Farming” on 10th November to learn about natural farming practices and the importance of sustainable agriculture .



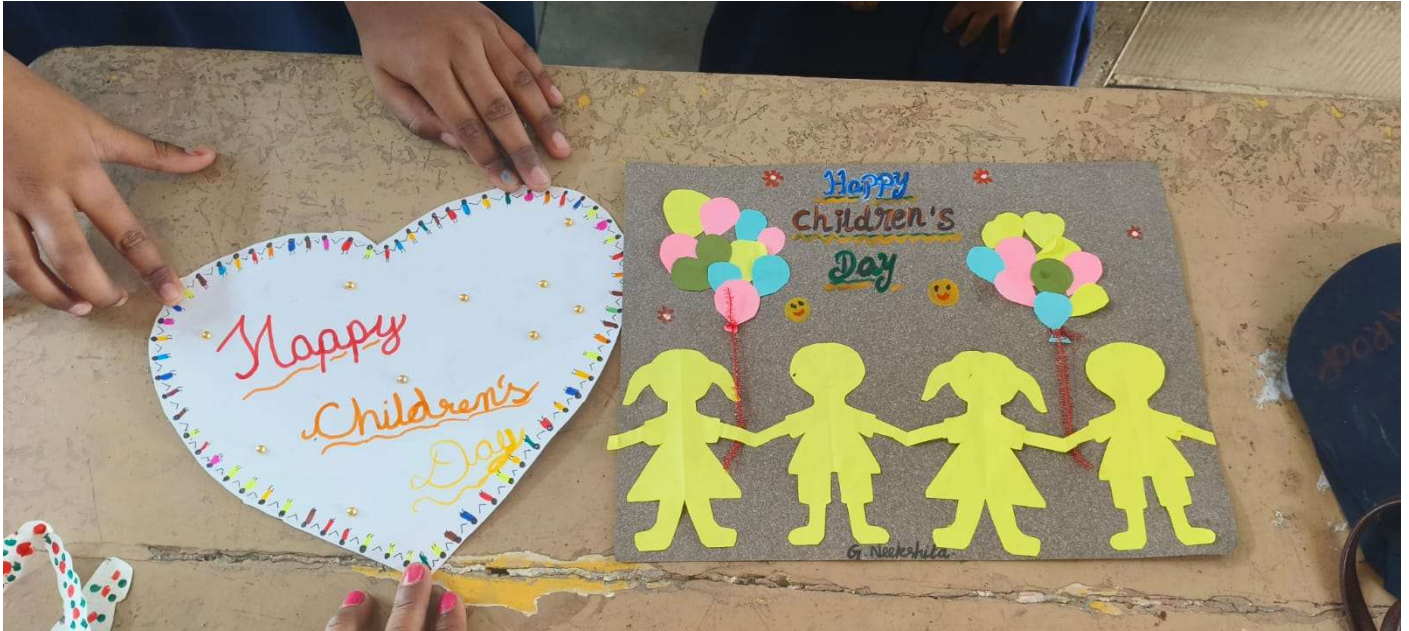
During the trip they observed how crops are grown without chemicals .The visit helped students appreciate the value of healthy soil and eco-friendly farming techniques.
